NEW BUSINESS	J. Elzinga presented the Commission with a report outlining efficiencies achieved by recent tenders in the amount of \$220,000 as well as a cut list showing items suggested for possible further reduction to project costs. A list of recommended cut list items (totaling \$400,000); recommended items to investigate for alternatives; items not recommended as well as recommended steps for the Commission to take were also presented in this report. These items came out of an architect/engineer meeting held with N. Olive and J. Elzinga earlier that day.
	The Commission reviewed their options to reduce the project costs by a target reduction amount of \$620,000 noting that \$220,000 had already been reduced through efficiencies achieved by recent tenders.
	It was moved and seconded
	To reduce improvements to second floor ice arena north concourse and to first floor ice arena existing dressing rooms (otherwise called the "spine") by \$160,000; to remove the arena lighting upgrade estimated at \$25,000; to reduce the amount budgeted for furniture and equipment by \$35,000; to reduce the amount budgeted for lighting controls by \$15,000; to take \$119,000 from the Reserve Fund if necessary and to reduce the project contingency fund by \$46,000.
