Shawnigan Lake Historical Society Notes to the Financial Statements Year ended December 31, 2021 (Unaudited - Prepared by management)

General:

The Shawnigan Lake Historical Society, the "Society", was reincorporated (SS-49716) under the British Columbia Society Act on September 20, 2005 (the Society lapsed briefly from its original incorporation in 1977 (S13397)) under the Provincial Charter as a "Not for Profit" organization with a charitable registration status of January 1, 1983 and the direction to operate as a Community History Museum.

Note 1: Fund accounting:

The Shawnigan Lake Historical Society ("The Society") follows the restricted fund method of accounting for contributions. The Society records its activities in the following funds:

The Operating Fund accounts for the organization's program delivery and transactions related to the maintenance of the facilities and general operations of the Museum. The fund reports unrestricted and restricted operating contributions.

The Capital Fund includes the transactions relating to the current building and a proposed building expansion. The Capital Fund include funds received from individuals, corporate donations and government grants that are designated for the building expansion.

Note 2: Capital Funds Cash. Building and Building in Progress

The Society has planned a project, "Project Impact", for an expansion of its present facilities. The Capital Funds Cash has an internal restriction on it's use to fund the project.

The Society currently has a cash reserve of \$381,451 (2020 - \$114,236) for expansion plans for "Project Impact". Total Project Impact costs are estimated at \$1,827,000. Additional grants totalling \$580,000 have been secured and are subject to proof of fund disbursements and project cash flow requirements.

Note 3: Furniture and Equipment, Fine Art, Exhibitions

Asset Valuation:

Recognition of contributions of capital assets help provide an understanding of the resources available to the organization and enables users of the financial statement to make comparisons with other organizations. When an estimate of fair market value cannot reasonably be made, both the capital asset and the related contribution would be recognized at nominal value. At the time of donation no reasonable value of some assets were able to be determined and were hence recorded at a nominal value.

Note 5: Effects of Covid-19

The Museum normally operates for eleven months out of a calendar year. During 2021 due to Covid 19 Ministry of Health for the Province of B.C. Orders, the Museum only operated for seven months (2020 - seven months and one-half). To offset some of the lost revenue and support wage expenditures during these reduced opening months for 2021 The Society received Federal employment grants of \$23,283 (2020 - \$24,585)
