- CVRD Bylaw No. 3607 In-House Curbside Collection Service Loan Authorization (Trucks and Totes) Bylaw, 2012, to purchase of three fully automated curbside collection trucks and 17,500 wheeled totes for an amount not to exceed \$1,775,000, to be paid back over 15 years, be forwarded to the Board for consideration of three readings, and, following provincial and voter approval, adoption.
- 3. Electoral approval be obtained over the entire service area through an alternate approval process for the adoption of Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 3607.
