Cowichan Valley ATV Club member, Mike Lees, stated that the Club president's presentation to the Board requesting that the Regional District put together an ATV Users Group to address ATV, dirt bike and mountain bike use in the Cowichan Valley has not yet happened. A statement pertaining to North Cowichan's motion to investigate the establishment of a recreational park for ATVs is something the Cowichan Valley ATV Club does not support. This mature group of ATV riders is focused on negotiating access agreements with local forest companies, as well as local and provincial governments. The idea of a recreation park could be a good idea for those interested in races for dirt bikes and ATVs as it would get them out of the woods and on to a track.

<u>Comments with regard to SR3 – Sandy Pool Regional Park</u>: The road access to the park was originally put in for the fire department to be able to pump water. This access is still used in the event of an emergency, so any changes to this area should take this into consideration.

Would also like to commend Parks staff for removing the under-burden and detritus from the parks, thus reducing the chance of fire.
