CVRD seeking volunteers to contribute to future plan for regional parks and trails

DUNCAN, BC – The Cowichan Valley Regional District (CVRD) is now accepting expressions of interest from volunteers to serve on the CVRD Regional Parks and Trails Master Plan Advisory Group.

The advisory group will provide input and feedback to the CVRD Board, staff and consultants, contributing throughout the planning process to update the CVRD Regional Parks and Trails Master Plan, beginning in early 2024. Volunteers will be selected by the CVRD Board who can bring a diversity of interests and knowledge applicable to regional parks and trails, including:

- Ecological and biodiversity conservation
- Outdoor recreation
- Indigenous interests
- Heritage conservation
- Accessibility and inclusivity
- Climate change mitigation and adaptation
- Parks and/or conservation area planning.

The advisory group will serve for the duration of the regional park plan update process anticipated to take 13 to 15 months to complete, involving participation in a number of meetings and attendance with public engagement events.
