

ADDENDUM NUMBER 1

ES-041-17 Youbou-Lake Cowichan Torrent Flow October 4, 2017

This Addendum shall be read in conjunction with and considered as an integral part of the Request for Proposals. Respondents should acknowledge the addendum on Appendix A the Submission Form.

The Addendum is as follows:

Question & Answers

Q1: Is it possible to extend the submission deadline?A1: We will extend the submission deadline. The new submission deadline is October 16, 2017@ 9 a.m. local time.

Q2: Will the CVRD provide the geospatial data not freely available through the CVRD website (e.g., historical LiDAR data and historical aerial photographs? Similar to the previous question, will the forestry owners provide the existing data and site-based information?
A2: CVRD data will be made available under a LUA. 2. Forestry operators will do the same for data respective to their areas

Q3: Can you specify the extent of the available LiDAR data (Section 2.3.2 of the RFP)? A3: This should be available for the area directly along the lakeshore from CVRD – TimberWest forestry operators have data for their area and we have been told it covers their lands. Data does not exist for the non-TimberWest lands.

Q4: Section 2.7 of the RFP indicates that the maximum funding available is \$185,000.00 inclusive of applicable taxes. Is the expectation that this project will be developed as a multi-year project and the \$185,000 is the funding available for year one? **A4:** \$185,000 is the total funding available for this project.

Q5: Will the CVRD provide the Climate Projection Data? E.g., raster data of precipitation projections as per data published in the report by the Cowichan Valley Regional District. (2017). **A5:** Yes the climate data will be available as netcdf files. The GIS raster data along with tabular data are available for download from our website on this page: <u>https://cvrd.bc.ca/climate</u>

Q6: Do you have an estimation of the number of briefing meetings with Stakeholders that we are expected to attend?

A6: The consultant will be expected to work with a stakeholder group at least 4 meetings, kick off, post hazard analysis, vulnerability analysis –likely 2, and at least one meeting discussing risk abatement – draft/final report presentation will also be expected.
