Business Arising:

Mayo Lake improvements: the contract went to the low bid of 24,550. Work included removal of the old pier and extension of the concrete walkway to the new pier, split rail fencing, and work on the parking lot including a culvert.

<u>Title consolidation for Mesachie Park</u>: staff consider this a low priority due to cost, time involved and more pressing priorities.

Director's Report:

There has been progress on development of a roadside pathway between the Robertson River and Honeymoon Bay.

Staff Report:

Graham Gidden provided an update on the Central Park playground. Input from the public meeting has been processed and incorporated into the plan. We are preparing the project for tender and anticipate work beginning in September 2018, to be completed before summer of 2019.

The Memory Lane commemorative sign is in production.

New Business:

MSC: to request staff investigate the feasibility of fencing between Central Park and new residential construction to prevent encroachment.

MSC: to paint the Lawn Bowling building and ER Seacare container to match the Honeymoon Bay Hall.

Problems have been reported in Mesachie Park with users parking on the basketball court and grass rather than in parking areas.
