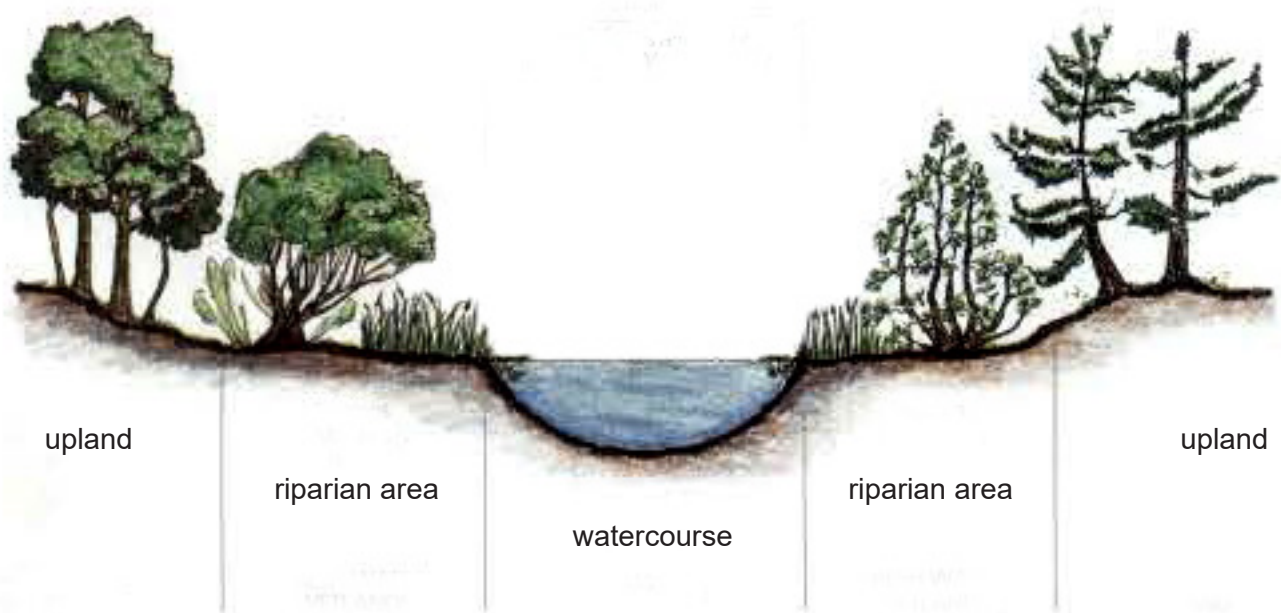


# Riparian Areas Regulation Property Declaration

The Province of British Columbia enacted the Riparian Areas Regulation to protect the critical features, functions and conditions required to sustain fish habitat. This legislation prohibits the CVRD from approving, or allowing a development to proceed adjacent to a riparian area or within a designated development permit area until it has received notice that a report prepared by a Qualified Environmental Professional (QEP) has been submitted to the Ministry of Environment.
